## CONFIRM YOUR VOTER REGISTRATION, REGISTER TO VOTE, OR UPDATE YOUR REGISTRATION

To help ensure a smooth Election Day sign in process, please make sure your voter registration information is current and accurate. You can check the status of your voter registration at [scVOTES.gov](https://scVOTES.gov).

### How to Register or Update Your Registration



#### Online at [scVOTES.gov](https://scVOTES.gov):

- Requires valid S.C. Driver's License or DMV ID.
- If you have moved, you must first update your address with DMV.



#### By mail:

- Download a voter registration form at [scVOTES.gov](https://scVOTES.gov) (requires a printer).
- Return the form by mail, fax or email.



#### In Person:

- Visit the Richland County voter registration and elections office.
- While receiving services at these agencies:
  - Armed Forces Recruiting Stations
  - Commission for the Blind
  - Department of Alcohol and Other Drug Abuse Services
  - Department of Health and Environmental Control
  - Department of Health and Human Services
  - Department of Mental Health
  - Department of Motor Vehicles
  - Department of Social Services
  - Vocational Rehabilitation Department



**Once your application is processed, you will receive a voter registration notification in the mail.**

#### Register or update your registration by the following deadlines for the November 3rd General Election:

- Online registration: **Sunday, October 4.**
- By-mail registration: **Must be postmarked by Monday, October 5.**
- In person: **Friday, October 2.**
